"Phishing" is a type of online fraud when criminals send you an email that looks like it has come from NewportFed. These phony emails may ask you to go to a web site that also looks like the NewportFed site and provide your personal account information. These emails may also ask you to call a phone number and provide account information.

NewportFed will never ask you to reveal personal identifying information such as social security number, password, account information or PIN number through unsolicited emails, phone calls or letters.
